1. Position and number of openings

Lecturer or Associate Professor (1 opening)

2. Duties

(1) Teaching English classes in the General Education curriculum;

(2) Planning and management of General Education English classes;

(3) Conducting education-related research and curricular development;

(5) Other duties related to English education.

3. Employment status and compensation

(1) Regular (full-time), under Kagawa University faculty appointment regulations

(Contract will be 5 years with the possibility of renewal; upon renewal, the position will become permanent (with no contract))

(2) Affiliation: Kagawa University Higher Education Center

(3) Compensation will be determined according to Kagawa University staff salary regulations; An annual wage plan will be applied.

4. Qualifications

(1) Applicants who have completed (or are expected to complete) a doctoral program (PhD), or possess equivalent or higher qualifications, are desirable.

(2) Applicants should have a background in English language teaching, applied linguistics, or a related field. Additionally, the applicant should have achievements in educational research related to the duties mentioned in 2 above.

(3) Applicants should have enthusiasm for improving foreign language education.

(4) Applicants should have enthusiasm for carrying out the work of the Higher Education Center.

(5) Applicants whose first language is not Japanese should have sufficient Japanese proficiency to carry out their work-related duties without difficulty.
